HELENE RECOVERY THANKSGIVING OFFERING

- **Hurricane Helene** left a trail of catastrophic damage in areas of Holston Presbytery along the Nolichucky River, Pigeon River, and numerous other creeks. Communities face years of costly recovery.
- **PC(USA) Response** The Presbyterian Disaster Assistance (PDA) program has supplied Holston Presbytery with immediate funds to help meet some urgent needs. PDA specialists also have been on-site, providing the Presbytery Disaster Response Team with counsel and encouragement.
- **Presbytery Response** The Presbytery Disaster Response Team is partnering with congregations to develop and implement ways to assist in their recovery.
